Rabbit anti Spenopentin

Spenopentin is an immunomodulatory pentapeptide corresponding to the amino acid residues 32-36 of the splenic hormone splenin.

This antibody was generated by immunization of rabbits with Spenopentin coupled to a carrier protein.

Quantity:	50µl
Format:	Neat undiluted antiserum, lyophilized, packaged under nitrogen. Reconstitute by adding 50µl distilled water. This will give the equivalent of undiluted antiserum.
Stability:	Original vial: at least one year at 4° - 8°C from date of delivery. Minimize repeated thawing and freezing of the antiserum by freezing aliquots at - 20°C or below.
Applications:	This antibody has been tested and validated in ELISA against Spenopentin. Other applications like immunohistochemistry (IHC), FACS or Western Blot may work as well. Optimal dilutions should be determined by the end user. Please see www.bma.ch for protocols and general information.
Immunogen:	Synthetic peptide H-Arg-Lys-Glu-Val-Tyr-OH coupled to carrier protein.
